3. The meeting **will have finished** / **will have been finishing** by noon.
4. By the appearance of the first star in the sky, **we will have sat** / **will have been sitting** at the table and **will have begun** / **will have been beginning** Christmas dinner.
5. The mechanic **will have fixed** / **will have been fixing** my car till 4 pm.
6. At 4 pm, the mechanic **will have fixed** / **will have been fixing** my car for two and a half hours.
7. The match **will have ended** / **will have been ending** by 8 pm.
8. At 1 pm, the marathon runner **will have run** / **will have been running** for 3 hours.
9. Their expedition **will have finished** / **will have been finishing** till 20<sup>th</sup> March.
10. I guess she **will have delivered** / **will have been delivering** the baby till early morning.
11. At 3 pm, she **will have delivered** / **will have been delivering** the baby for over 12 hours.
12. By tomorrow morning, the six mountain climbers **will have been rescued** / **will have been rescuing** by the rescuers for 24 hours.
13. She **will have read** / **will have been reading** the novel by midday.
14. The hairdresser **will have cut** / **will have been cutting** my hair by 2 pm.
15. By noon, the peloton **will have cycled** / **will have been cycling** for 5 hours.

1. Zamierzam zmodyfikować swoje plany na wakacje.  
I am going to modify my plans.

When are you going to end this pointless dispute?
3. O której godzinie zamierzasz wyjść z pracy?  
What time are you going to leave work?
4. Spójrz na drzewo. Zaraz się przewróci.  
Look at the tree. It is going to collapse.
5. Spójrz na wulkan. Zaraz wybuchnie.  
Look at the volcano. It is going to erupt.

## WILL

1. Przypuszczam, że Święta będą ciepłe i bez śniegu.  
I suppose Christmas will be warm and without snow.
2. Nie sądzę, że Tom mi przebaczy.  
I don't think that Tom will forgive me.
3. Myślę, że zrzucę kilka kilogramów do wakacji.  
I think I will shed some kilogram till holidays.
4. Obawiam się, że twoja choroba będzie się rozwijać.  
I am afraid your disease will develop / progress.
5. Przypuszczam, że nasza gospodarka napotka problemy. (encounter problems)  
I suppose our economy will encounter problems.

1. Będę lecieli do Madrytu jutro między 16:00 a 18:30.  
They will be flying to Madrid between 4 and 6:30 pm.
2. Adele będzie nagrywała nową piosenkę w przyszły weekend.  
Adele will be recording a new song next weekend.
3. Jutro około 20:00 będę oglądał film w kinie.  
Tomorrow at 8 pm I will be watching a film at the cinema.
4. Malarz będzie malował mój pokój w weekend.  
The painter will be painting my room next weekend.
5. W przyszłym tygodniu będę odpoczywała na Krecie.  
I will be relaxing on Crete next week.

### WILL + HAVE + PAST PARTICIPLE

1. Odkurzę pokój do wieczora.  
I will have vacuumed / hovered the room till evening.
2. Skończę studia do czerwca 2018.  
I will have graduated from university till 2018. I will have ended my studies till 2018.
3. Wykład skończy się do 20 minut.  
The lecture will have finished within 20 minutes.
4. Paczki dotrą do ciebie do środy.  
Parcels will have been delivered to you till Wednesday. You will have received parcels by Wednesday.
5. Do wtorku otrzymasz mój przelew.  
You will have got / received my transfer till Tuesday.
